- Who has financial need.
- Who has contributed to the community.
- Who has demonstrated scholastic achievement.
- Who is enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution.

To be considered for this award, each applicant must supply:

- 1. A completed Application Form received by April 30th, 2024.
- 2. Two current letters of reference
- 3. A copy of your last High School transcript
- 4. A copy of the acceptance letter or proof of enrollment, including registration number from an accredited post-secondary institution.
- 5. A cover letter
