

Parent Portal MyEd BC

A secure, web-based portal for parent/legal guardians, students and teachers to communicate student information.



What is MyEd?

MyEd BC is a secure, provincial student information database which is used to collect and manage student information used for educational program and administrative purposes.

What is Parent Portal?

A secure, web-based portal that allows parent/legal guardians on-line access to their child/ward's student information.

Is the information secure?

Student information is protected by the rules and regulations of the School Act and Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act. Users only have access to their child/ward's information.

How do I get started?

All parent/legal guardians will receive a computer generated email which contains a link to the MyEd BC website, a Login ID and a temporary password. Please check your JUNK or SPAM email folders.

If you didn't receive the email. **Do not create your own account.** It will not be linked to your child/ward's student information. If you didn't receive the email, send an email to cssparentportal@sd79.bc.ca for an account inquiry.

You can log into the MyEd BC website from any computer that connects to the internet.



How do I access my account?

Log in to the MyEd BC's Parent Portal with the information you received in your email.

1. Go to <https://myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/logon.do>
2. Enter your Login ID and temporary password
3. You will be prompted immediately to change your password


Changing your password

When choosing a new password, please refer to the following guidelines:

- Password must be a minimum of eight characters
- Password must contain at least one number
- Password must contain one capital and one lowercase letter
- Password must contain at least one symbol that isn't a letter or a number
- Password cannot contain 'password', login name, first name, middle name, last name, date of birth, personal id, or only a sequence of letters or numbers
- Samples of acceptable password: Jan2017\$, Snow999!, Welcome1\$
- Write your password down and keep it in a secure area for future reference
- Passwords are good for 90 days, at which time after a successful login you will be required to create a new password immediately.

Locked out of account?

Five unsuccessful login attempts will disable your account and if this happens, you can request that your account be re-activated by emailing cssparentportal@sd79.bc.ca or clicking the "I forgot my password" link to reset your password.



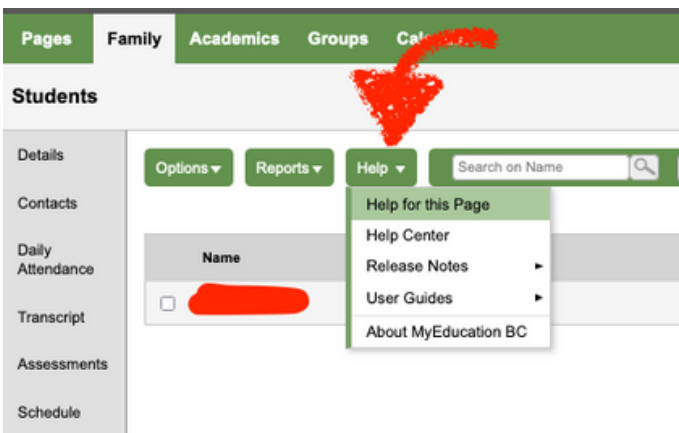
