2019 / 2020 BUSING INFORMATION

- An email will be sent to all registered riders indicating when routing information will be available on eLink (approximately August 14th). eLink instructions are on back of this letter.
- TO CONFIRM YOUR STUDENT'S ROUTING INFORMATION & EMERGENCY CONTACTS you will need the following information to log on to eLink:

- Drivers will be provided with ridership lists and students will only be permitted to ride buses they are registered to. It is imperative that parents ensure that their students have correct bus route information.
- Bus passes will be available for pickup at your child(ren)'s school August 26, 2019. All

 and ridership will be cancelled.

School fees will remain the same for next year (2019-2020). We will continue to have an <u>annual</u> Student Activity Fee of \$25, a one-time Textbook Deposit (refundable) of \$25, and a graduation fee of \$55 (paid in grade 12). Students/families only have to pay the Textbook Deposit fee once (generally in grade 10). If all textbooks are returned in good condition, the deposit will be refunded or credited against other fees owing.


