

Indigenous Technologies 11 class went on a field trip to Ye'Yumnuts, a sacred ancestral place of the Cowichan people and an ancient archeological site. Together with Graduate students from the University of Victoria, we learned from Dianne Hinkley of Cowichan Tribes and Professor Brian Thom from UVic. We were taught some of the history of the site and shown some archeological artifacts that were found there. Some of the artifacts date back over







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
