OR:

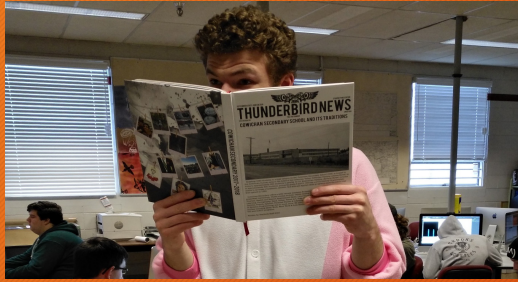

Windows/Mac:

Type "cowichan.appazur.com" into your Chrome/Firefox/Safari/Edge browser.

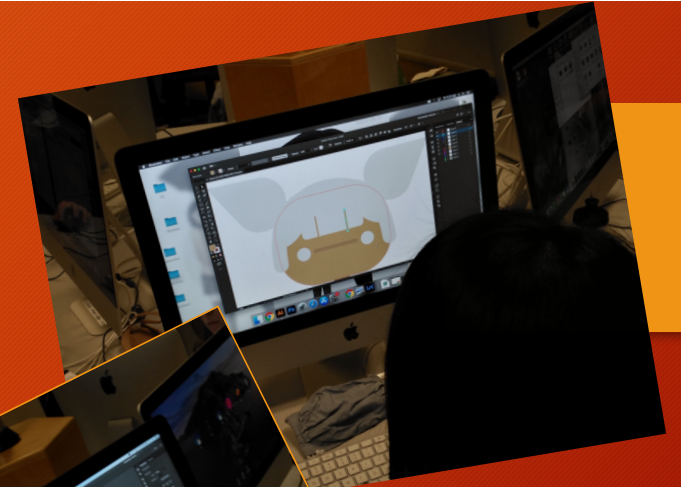

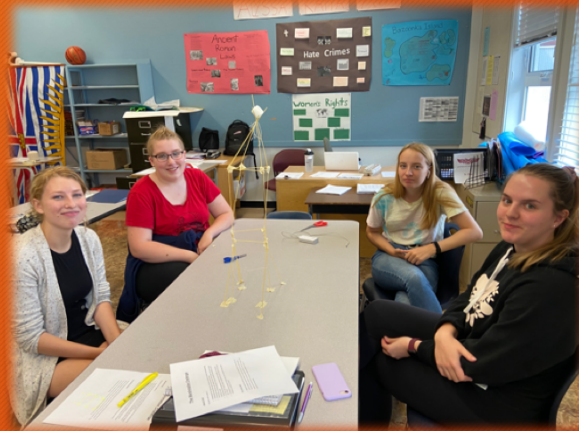
Ms. Donnelly's Graphics class is working hard at creating incredible pieces of art using lines, shapes and colours. They also played around with making Logos of their initials.

- Masks must be worn at all times.
