COVID Reminders:

Parents and Students are reminded to observe the following:

- Students must do a daily health assessment before coming to school. If students have any symptoms associated with COVID (these include fever, chills, cough or worsening of chronic cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, runny nose, loss of sense of smell or taste, headache, fatigue, diarrhea, loss of appetite, nausea and vomiting and muscle aches), they must not attend school and must be symptom free before attending.
- Students must wear a mask in common areas (hallways). We are finding some students are coming to school without masks and we are in very short supply of disposable replacement masks.
- Students must sanitize or wash hands any time they are entering the building.
- Practice physical distancing when with students outside of cohort.




Ms. Veraflores' and Mr. Lofto's Environmental Stewardship class

Students in this class were working on an "Art is..." drawing.


