

COVID Reminders for Students and Parents



Students are to do a daily health assessment before each school day and staff home if symptomatic. More info at:

- Students must wear a mask on the bus and in the halls (and other common areas) where they cannot maintain 2 meters of distance.
- Students are to wash hands when entering the school and after breaks and lunch.
- Students will not use lockers. As well, water fountains (but not bottle filling stations) have been turned off. Students advised to bring a water bottle.
- Students are to maintain 2 meters apart when with students in a different learning group.



Safety Measures at CSS




We are making our school as safe as we can by:

- Organizing students into Cohorts (Learning Groups) in order to minimalize contacts and help with tracing if needed.
- Increased cleaning of rooms and high touch areas.
- Staggering breaks, lunch and end of day dismissal (latest is still 3:15)
- Providing students and staff with masks.
- Controlling the directional flow in hallways to reduce contacts.
- 12 temporary hand washing stations have been installed in our halls.

Windows/Mac:

Type "cowichan.appazur.com" into your Chrome/Firefox/Safari/Edge browser.

☐ Tap the menu button (" " icon at the top left).
☐ In the menu, tap "Sign In". Use your school account if you have one. Otherwise: If you have not signed in before, "Sign Up" for a new account.
☐ Tap "Classes" in the menu, then tap the gear to select your classes.
☐ Tap "Groups" in the menu, then tap the gear to select your clubs, teams, and other groups that you belong to.
In the menu, tap the " " with your name next to it, and pick how you want to receive notifications
