Graduation Numeracy Assessment

From November 3-5 all grade 11 students will be writing the Provincial Graduation Numeracy Assessment. Normally, this is written in grade 10 but these students were to scheduled to write this in April last school year. Due to the school closure, they were unable to do this. A few things to know about this assessment:

- All students must write this prior to graduation.
- There is no pass or fail. Students are assessed on a four-point proficiency scale.
- The mark is not blended with any subject. Students will receive a mark of 1-4 on their transcript.
- The Numeracy Assessment is not a "Math Exam". Rather, it is an assessment of numerical concepts learned across many subject areas from grade K-9.
- Students are able to retake this in order to upgrade their proficiency score.
- Grade 11 students had an information session in their A block classes on Thursday. Many A block teachers plan to continue preparing students for this.




