

- Large school projects that will not fit on the student's lap

Items which CAN be transported:

- A regular size back pack that sits comfortably on the student's lap
- Small band instruments such as flutes, trumpets- anything up to the size of (and including) an alto saxophone
- Balls contained within the student's backpack
- Skateboards completely enclosed in a zippered bag (no longboards)
- Grass/Field Hockey sticks completely enclosed

K-12 STAFF:


K-12 STUDENTS:

All students in Grades 4 to 12 are required to wear a mask or a face shield (in which case a nonmedical mask should be worn in addition to the face shield) indoors in schools and on school buses - both within and outside of their learning group.
