

Deadline to accept admission offers: May I

Entrance scholarship update

Any applicants who have missed the deadline to accept their UVic Entrance Scholarship must contact the Student Awards Office directly if they would like to request reinstatement (this cannot come from a parent or counsellor). Offers will only be reinstated until May 14, at which point, students must wait until their final grades are submitted by the Ministry of Education to be reconsidered. Applicants must email the UVic Scholarship Assistant at awards4@uvic.ca with their full name, student number and a brief explanation outlining why they did not accept their scholarship by the required deadline.
