

A reminder to graduating students who haven't done so already, to make their PSI selections in the StudentTranscripts Service (STS). Students wishing to send May interim marks to one of six B.C. PSIs, University of Alberta or University of Calgary must place orders by April 23rd. Also, 22 B.C. PSIs and the Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC) can now receive interim marks and transcript updates electronically throughout the year (when authorized by the student).

MASK REQUIREMENT UPDATES


K-12 STAFF:
