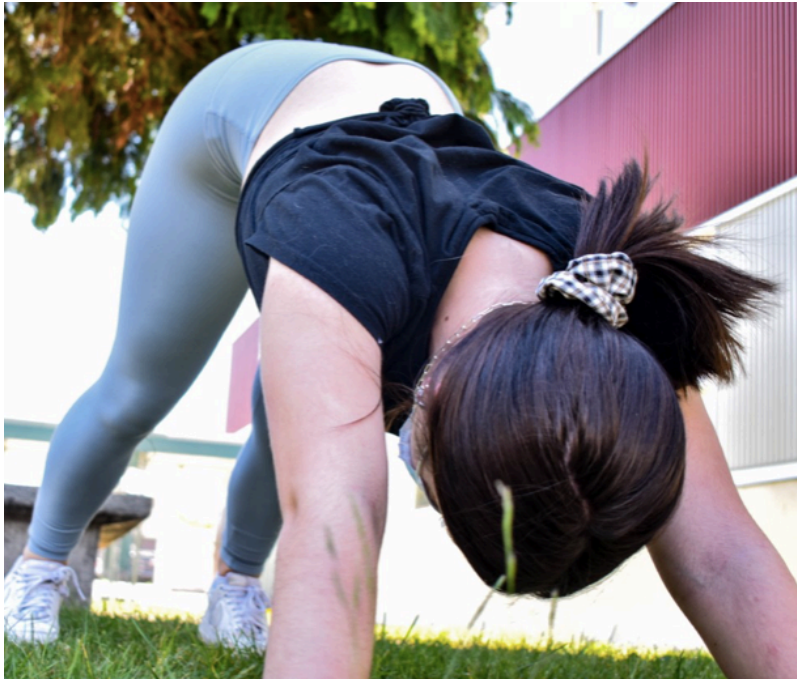
COURTYARD BAND CONCERT GRADE 10-12

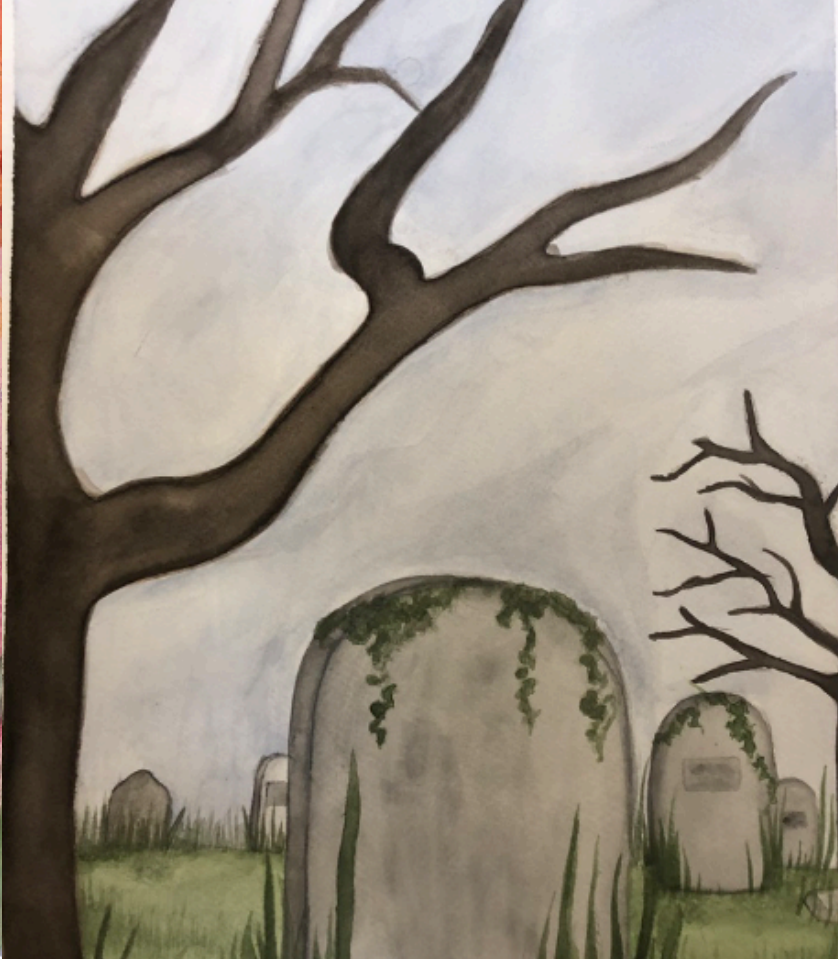
